



Standards for Exhibited Artwork

1. Artist agrees to provide any specialized hardware necessary for installation
2. Artwork Information (including title, year, media, value) must be included with artwork upon delivery to gallery.
3. Exhibited works may not present a health and/or safety hazard to staff, visitors, artists, or gallery occupants. Works may not incorporate open flames or explosive materials.
4. Exhibited works may not block exit door, walkways, or wheelchair access
5. Works incorporating paint or adhesives must be dry upon delivery to gallery.
6. Works may not be installed using adhesive. (Velcro tape is acceptable provided that the section applied to the wall is secured by staples or screws.)
7. Technology (Projectors, monitors, DVD Players, Speakers) must be secured with cables.
8. Sculptural work must be secured against movement or earthquake, with wire/cables, putty, or display mounts.
9. Small work (Sculptures under 14", 2D under 10") secured with wire/cables or other means approved by Pro Arts staff.
10. Large (over 50") frames/canvases must be installed with cleats or 'D' rings, not hanging wire.
